Pro Shop Business

Sam discussed the issue of how to deal with areas on the course that appear to warrant GUR status but are not so marked. In medal play the golfer can play as it lies as well as a second ball following a drop. The concern is then taken to the golf pro or his assistant. In match play there is no recourse and the golfer must play the ball as it lies, with one exception. If both competitors agree, the golfer can take a drop.

Winter Rules are in effect which allow lift, clean, and place within one club length in fairway areas. In non-fairway areas, lift, clean, and place within six inches anywhere that the ball can be played.

The Pro Shop was requested to have games on Wednesday throughout the offseason and Sam agreed to do so.

Today is Beat the Officers Day. If the Officers win, they get all the money. Otherwise, there will be three places paid, which could be the Officers if they place second or third.
